- 1. Log in to IU Scholarships by navigating to <u>one.iu.edu</u>.
- 2. Search for "Scholarships."
- 3. Click on the "IU Scholarships" task and log in.



- 4. Click on "Opportunities" in the header bar.
- 5. Complete IU's General Application found in the left hand column.

4. What is your intended enrollment status for the upcoming academic year? (full-time, at least half-time, less than half-time)

5. Do you plan to work during the school year?

6. Required Scholarship Essay. If you do not feel you would like to disclose any of the information requested in the essay prompts, you do not need to. However, including information about financial hardships and/or future career goals may help the selections committees determine your eligibility for certain awards. If you don't wish to include an essay, simply type anything into this field (i.e. "N/A").

7. Are you ready to submit your general application? Select "Yes"

Then type your name into the Signature Statement at the bottom the page.
